FATHER JOHN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then repelled a bid in the stretch and cleared the field late. CHOW WAGON tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung late. NEED MONEY DAD chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch. WIND RIDER stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. CINCO ESTRELLA was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. BLUE RYDER RED angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat. THANKS BE TO GOD was through after a half. FINAL PITSTOP was done early.
