GRUENEWALD rated back in the four path, made a mild four wide advance around the far turn, steadily gained outside through the stretch and was along in time. FAST EDDIE CHARLES set the pace in the two path, was collared leaving the three-eighths pole, vied inside of MUTED WORD from there past the eighth pole and came again late to re-gain the place. MUTED WORD stalked the pace in the three path, bid in the three path outside of the pacesetter down the backstretch, took the lead near the three-eighths pole, vied outside of FAST EDDIE CHARLES from there to deep stretch and weakened. EL TAJIN failed to menace while racing three and four wide. RED SANDY lagged inside, raced in the four path around the far turn and passed tiring rivals. FOUL TROUBLE was no factor inside. BIGSURPRISEMISTER tracked the pace in the clear in the four path and tired.
