MISS INDY CINDY tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then rallied late in the stretch and was just up at the wire. GOLD GLORY set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch but was caught at the wire. WAVE LAND MABEE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. CITY SWEETS was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. SQUARE TOE BOOTS stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. SHOW ME CLASS swung into the six path in the far turn while no threat. LIGHT EM UP RICH was through after a half. SECRET ORDER showed little. IZZA STAR was never involved. PAIGE'S GOLD had early speed then folded up.
