Footnotes

CHECK UP pressed the pace two wide, took command near the five-sixteenths pole, drew clear in upper stretch and held clear under a steady drive. STORM N ROSIE LACE angled to the rail entering the turn, settled just off the pace around the bend and finished well to gain the place. VIN SANTO prompted the pace three wide and finished evenly to preserve the show. MY GAL SUNDAY lacked speed, raced along the rail and finished well. CALERA APPEAL raced four and five wide and improved her position. ALIBI GIRL stalked the pace three and four wide and faded in the stretch. GRIPEY SARAH lacked speed inside and passed tiring rivals. A TOUCH OF HUMOR set a pressured pace along the rail, stopped in mid stretch and was eased through the final sixteenth. PRINCESS CUGAT never factored while racing two and three wide.
