BOUNTY HUNTER chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drove past the leaders in the stretch and cleared the field late. TEE'S PROSPECT was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. TWINKLES MAGIC dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. FLAT OUT RICH stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. WALLSTREET CHARLIE dueled early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. MAGIC ROCK was never a threat. WAKI PASSAGE was done early. MOONSHINE STILL hit the gate at the start and was turned sideways.
