BRICKYARD was allowed to settled while racing on the inside down the backstretch, rallied strongly then waited for racing room at the top of the stretch, was in a strong drive to power up and take command inside the furlong marker then was ridden out in the end. SAHMMY DAVIS JR set the pace from the start, was in control heading into the far turn, then was in a hard drive in the stretch but failed to last in the end. HEZA WILD GUY was settled then rallied four wide on the far turn making a strong bid in the stretch but came up empty in late stretch. SEAPOPS pressed the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was used up on the far turn and faltered in the drive. ELLENBERGER PARK was unhurried early then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. BEG MEL was unhurried early and failed to menace when asked. X BOSS chased the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered. GUNNER was inside in the early going, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
