SCATTERFIELD vied for the early lead then duel on the inside on the turn, drew off in mid stretch then was kept to task in the end. PASS THE CROWN was allowed to settle then rallied three wide for the stretch, made a bid and was along for the place. UNREACHABLE STAR was allowed to settle then rallied along the inside in the stretch, was gaining ground but hung in late stretch. HOOSIER KINGDOM was unhurried early then rallied in upper stretch while five wide in the stretch and was no menace in the end. SNEAKIN AWAY was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide in the stretch and was no threat. BUSTER ROSE vied for the early lead while racing three wide into the turn, was was two wide on the turn but was used up and gave way in the drive. HARD LUCK MONK chased the pace while racing four wide into the turn, was used up and faltered in the stretch. DOCTOR MARK was allowed to settled then showed no effort after that. DEMI FLAME was no factor and being outrun. BELLA'S FELLA vied for the lead while inside, was used and stopped in the stretch drive.
