Footnotes

COWBOY CHRISTMAS chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch with a long drive and prevailed in the final stages. BAHIM pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. LAKE PLEASANT was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. WINNING VERDICT was back early, angled off the rail into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. PIANO MAGIC was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. TSUNAMI KING tracked pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faded late. STAGE SUCCESS stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive. METEOR STREAK set the pace for a half then soon retreated.
