Footnotes

WILMINGTON stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. SLUMBUSTER was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. FILLAZZENNE was back early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. TACTICAL DISCOVERY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. ORCHARD chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. MIZ KATE DOVEY was on the inside into the far turn while no threat. CHAMPANNIE was through after a half. TWO STEPPIN' TANGO had early speed then retreated.
