SEATTLE BY THE SEA set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. RAPID SURVIVOR was unhurried early, while on the inside into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out in the drive. CLIFF'S BEST BET tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late. CROWN'S BIG DAY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn with no late bid in the stretch run. OCK MAN was far back early, angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch. OLD SMOOTHIE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. MOROS LAUNCHER was never involved. CLIFF'S LONGSHOT was done early. ROOF TINNER was through after a half.
