STALWART TEE was well placed early, angled into the five path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. MO FASTER stalked the dueling leaders early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. FATHER ART was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. UNLOOSENED BIT was back early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. JACKS ARE LUCKY dueled early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. PRESIDENTIAL BALL dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch. VERY CLEAR was through after a half. M'NAUGHTEN was always outrun.
