ELLENBERGER PARK was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. BENJI BLUES stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, took over the lead in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. NORTHERN SWEEPER was far back early, angled into the four path in the turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. TURN TONY TURN angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. GARCON tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. FATHER MICK was never a threat. BROTHER JERRY set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch. OSCEORO was done early. FRANS DEPUTY was always outrun. STEALNTHISONE was never involved.
