STRAWBERRY AMOUR was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field late. ARTICLE stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. DIAMOND DANGO chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. MAGGIE'S BEST set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. BRENT THE BANKER angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch. WILD SIP was through after a half. LAST STAMP angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. ROYAL GENT showed little. RUMORS EVERYWHERE had early speed then folded up.
