DONE GONE dueled for the lead while racing two wide then drew off on the turn, was in a long sustained drive and held sway in the end. BAREFOOT BANDIT rallied three wide on the turn making a bid but was only second best in the end. KELA'S BOY was unhurried early then moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive, made a late rally but was no menace to the top two. LORENZO'S FOREST was well placed while inside into the turn, saved ground but failed to menace in the stretch drive. PENNY PINCHIN PAT dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. PANDERING stalked the pace while racing two wide into the turn then was no threat. SPRING MEET was inside and no factor throughout. BECKNERVILLE raced five wide on the turn and was outrun.
