BIG BAD BLUE chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn, took over command and drew away late in the stretch under a brisk drive. JIM'S SMOKIN PINOT was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. NICKY'S DELIGHT was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. NEW YORK SOLUTION raced up close early, angled into the three path in the far turn with no late bid in the stretch. TIMEFORAHARICANE was back early, angled into the four path in the far turn and improved position late. FASTCARS N FREEDOM angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat. MACONITQUICK stalked the pace early, led the field briefly, while on the inside into the far turn and faded late. DR. REDNECK was through after a half. COP BEAT was pulled up and vanned off.
