MANA WINDS stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. TUFF COOPER was bumped at the start then set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. POSH'S FAIRY TALE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. JUS PUDDIN YAWL was never a threat. BOBBY'S BIG BOY showed little. WILL DOMINATE was done early. MULTISTORM was never a factor.
