HALO CASPER was bumped at the start then tracked the early pace, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. EXCITING ACTION was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and was up for place late. MANA WINDS stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. TUFF COOPER was bumped at the start then set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. POSH'S FAIRY TALE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. JUS PUDDIN YAWL was never a threat. BOBBY'S BIG BOY showed little. WILL DOMINATE was done early. MULTISTORM was never a factor.
