T. was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. FERDIE'S GOT IT tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. H K JUNIOR chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and lacked a late gain in the stretch run. I SEE A SHARK stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch. X PLAYBOY was through after a half. JAYDEE was done early. HUNTINGTON'S BEST had early speed then folded up.
