**Footnotes**

SIREN STAR was allowed to settle in mid pack, rallied on the rail leaving the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and bumped ISLE OF TUNES, gained the lead inside the furlong marker, quickly kicked clear then was taken in hand late. ISLE OF TUNES was well placed from the start, made a bid three wide entering the stretch, was bumped by SIREN STAR near the three-sixteenths pole, and was outfinished. GOLD IDEA dueled on the outside of a rival, battled gamely into the final furlong, and gave way. BRANDI DRIVE settled in mid pack, raced three wide on the turn, and lacked the needed rally in the stretch. ANYWHERE ANYTIME dueled on the inside of GOLD IDEA, vied with that rival into the final furlong, and faded. PATTON'S BEST was void of early speed, raced well back in the field, and failed to menace. WINTER FLIGHT threw her head after the start, raced towards the rear, and was no factor. MENTIRINHA raced up close on the inside, dropped back on the turn, and saved ground to no avail. STAR SITE was always outrun. DANCING CRISIS was declared a non-starter. Following a stewards inquiry, DANCING CRISIS was declared a non-starter for not receiving a fair start.
