SUPERSTARDOM chased the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn then took over command in the stretch and held in the final stages. SHE CAN FLY was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. LIL PRICKLY CACTUS was settled off the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but was too late. WILDCAT JILLEE was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with some late gain in the stretch run. MINNIE CHANCE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. LOOKING DUBAI angled into the four path in the turn with a belated gain in the stretch. LOUIMPRESME stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. ROYAL RENAISSANCE set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive.
