HARTMANS KOMET pressed the pace while inside, rallied on the inside on the turn then was in a hard drive and proved best in the end. MY MAN JACK was unhurried early then rallied six wide in the stretch and was up for the place. COMPLACENCY set a pressured pace while two wide, was hard used then weakened in late stretch. RED WHISPER was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, moved out to be six wide for the stretch drive and closed ground in late stretch. MY SON DARREN raced three wide on the turn making a bid then faltered in the stretch drive. CHECK THIS ORDER was unhurried early then raced seven wide for the stretch but was no factor. MANCHESEE MANCHEDO saved ground on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. WHATA WAKI was inside and saving ground but was not no factor in the end. SEARCH THE LOU raced six wide on the turn and was no factor. INTERCEPTED showed some brief speed while three wide, was hard used and stopped.
