### Footnotes

TENMOR was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn then waited for room inside the quarter pole and angled to the rail inside the three sixteenth pole then was driven clear in the final stages. CHOW WAGON was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch but to no avail. BEG MEL was back early, angled into the five path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung late. RAHY NIJMIS pressed the pace early, angle3d into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. FINAL PITSTOP chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. MOONSHINE STILL set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch. ARROSON tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive.
