MOONSHINE STILL was well placed early then steadied into the turn, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole and drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared late. STORMIN LARRY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. SODA JERK was bumped and squeezed back at the start then checked into the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. CHURUBUSCO angled off the rail into the turn and improved position in the stretch run. TANK'S LETTER tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. AMY'S BUDDHA pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch.
