CONTEMPORARY dueled early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed in the final stages. BUCKTOWN vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. BIG REWARD trailed the field early, angled into the three path in the turn with some gain in the stretch drive. REDDICK TOWNSHIP chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. HUMOR'S PUNCH angled off the rail into the turn and lacked a bid in the stretch run. ROYAL JAKE was through after a half.
