MISS DAKOTA chased the winner into the lane from just off the rail then could not gain on that one while finishing second best. IMBRACHIUM chased the leaders from the inside then could only gain the minor share. CHARLIE PAPA stalked the leaders into the lane then had nothing to offer. WAY FLEETER raced in the four path through the turn and moved up through the lane while not a threat. GOOD RIDDANCE was never a factor while racing in the three path through the turn. STEPH'S TEE tired along the inside. SWEET TAFFY was outrun from the four path. TASTE SWEET was outrun along the inside.
