SOMETHING ALARMING settled off the pace outside, came four wide into the lane, reached near even terms in mid stretch and drove clear. SATANGO was bumped leaving the chute, tracked the pace three wide, bid between rivals in mid stretch and finished willingly. STORMY DECEPTION lacked speed in the three path, began to rally inside of horses in upper stretch, lugged out near the eighth pole and was along for third. SWEEP THE CODE came out and bumped RAFAE HOLLISTER into SANTANGO leaving the chute, stalked the pace two wide, reached near even terms in mid stretch and weakened i the final sixteenth. EVANS THUNDER set the pace along the rail, was collared leaving the eighth pole and weakened. SIR PRESLEY failed to menace. RAFAE HOLLISTER was bumped leaving the chute, stalked the pace three wide, was forced to check when STORMY DECEPTION lugged out near the eighth pole and offered no further response. BROTHER WALTER was fractious in the starting gate and never a factor. GREAT SKY DANCER popped the gate open prior to the start then had only brief speed. GOING A. W. O. L. was off slow then trailed.
