CAUSIN CONFUSION moved clear soon after the start, widened through the turn and continued to extend the advantage to the end while being kept to the task with intermittent right-handed urging. FACE IN THE MIRROR chased the pace from the two path, split rivals leaving the turn to get nearest the winner, could not gain on that one and was all out to hold the place spot. DRAGON FUSE chased the pace along the inside then lacked the needed response through the final eighth and just missed the place spot. BALLACOLLA raced four wide throughout and lacked the needed effort through the lane. PRIME INDICATOR chased the winner through the turn from the two path then tired. LEMON DROP HIGH saved ground into the lane then passed a couple rivals while never a threat. ROCK N GROHL chased the pace three wide through the turn, fanned five wide into the lane then tired. HOOSIER REDNECK was through early while racing in the four or five path through the turn.
