Footnotes

SIDE CUT HALO vied for the lead two wide through the turn, repelled challenger entering the lane, opened a clear advantage then held. SPURTABILITY chased the pace two or three wide through the turn, moved closest to the winner in the lane but could not gain while finishing second best. UNBRIDLED ZIP tracked the pacesetters along the inside into the lane then lacked the needed response while saving the minor share. EGGMOGGIN REACH raced along the inside into the lane then offered a belated gain. STORM CELLAR was in the two or three path into the lane then moved up without being a serious threat. THINK ABOUT YOU was along the inside throughout and offered a mild bid. SUNDAY PARK was four or five wide through the turn and was empty in the lane. BEGONE was outrun while in the three or for path. I RULE YOU FOOL vied for the lead through the turn then retreated in the lane. DEVILISH TEE chased the pace from the three or four path and was empty entering the lane.
