Footnotes

CANOOK tracked the early pace inside, had to steady slightly into the turn, angled out into the stretch to get through between rivals, headed the pace setter at the eighth pole, drove clear the final sixteenth and held that lead. L J'S WAY well back and off the rail, circled the field through the turn, came six wide into the stretch, made a steady advance to get up for the place late. MOUNTAIN TRAIL well back and off the rail, bid five wide into the stretch, closed well but did not have enough late. GRINDER sprinted to a clear lead, was challenged by the winner at the eighth pole, dueled with that one and weakened the last sixteenth. LEGIONARY well back, passed tiring rivals through the stretch. BUCKWILD chased the pace inside, faded in the drive. HE'S THE BEST fractious in the gate, was well placed three wide, then had no stretch rally. REALLY STORMY close up and outside early, bid widest through the turn, then had no stretch rally. CAME TO SCORE broke in at the start and showed little. SAHM'S'L'SOLDIER was no factor outside.
