HURRY HOME WARREN second flight and on the rail, made a steady advance, angled out at the sixteenth pole and just got past BRENT'S BAD BOY at the wire. BRENT'S BAD BOY set the pace from between rivals, drew clear and increased his lead at the three sixteenth pole, shortened stride in the late going and was outfinished in the final strides. CHOW WAGON void of speed and off the rail, came around rivals through the turn to bid five wide into the stretch, got up for the show spot in the final strides while no threat to the top two. LATIN NOTE bumped by a rival at the start, was well back and outside, angled in into the turn, had a steady gain and lost the show spot in the final strides. TYPHOONIGATOR never far back, bid five wide into the stretch, then had no late response while drifting in. NOBLE DEVIL improved his position outside. BRASS BOLT close up and on the rail, weakened in the drive. SIR DAKOTA broke out and bumped a rival at the start, bid five wide, then had no rally. CHECK IN ADVANCE pressed the early pace outside, faded in the stretch run. HAARMAN stalked three wide and was through after a half.
