RUPERTS COOKIE stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late in the stretch. SODA JERK dueled early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. HONEST PROPHET was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. PROUD EXPRESSION tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch drive. THRU THE DESERT angled off the rail into the turn while no threat. MY MAN JAY chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and faded late. JESS Z dueled early then soon retreated. U TEACHEM CART was done early.
