Footnotes

THEGREATCROSBY was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch from the rail and was up late. GO GETEM dueled early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn, led late in the stretch but was caught at the wire. DA DA DA DUM pressed the pace early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn and missed in the final stages. PIMM'S O'CLOCK chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. SPEEDY HIT dueled early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and weakened late. DEW DETIME was done early. LETEM FLY trailed the field throughout.
