CRIMSON'S ROAR set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. I'MA GANGSTER chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drifted out in the stretch and flattened out late. SUCCESSFULARGUMENT was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. BIG SAND HILL was back early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. O WHAT A DREAM stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. THE BOY FROM ROY tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then altered course in the stretch but had nothing left late. UR UP ZIP was never a threat. DRINKABILITY was through after a half. SLEEPY FITZ was done early. STRAVAGANCES trailed the field throughout.
