ROYAL ANSWER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. MAGIC MEMORY chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late and held place. DONTSTOP ONGREEN trailed the field early, angled into the five path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch but missed place late. SHAGGY MCPHEE was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. HUSHER bobbled at the start and swung into the six path in the turn. CHANCE ALMIGHTY was never a threat. PRIAPUS angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. FORTYFOUR HUNTER stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. RICH AND CREAMY was through after a half.
