STALWART TEE was allowed to settled while racing on the inside, saved ground on the backstretch and far turn, rallied in upper stretch and powered to the front in late stretch and was best in the end. NEED MONEY DAD was well placed while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn making a bid then was blocked in mid stretch and angled out to be five wide in late stretch then was up for the place in the end. ROYALY LUCKEY was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn making a strong drive to mid stretch then came up empty in late stretch. NEW YORK GIN pressed the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was hard used then gave way in the stretch drive. TWO HONOR GLENDON set a pressed pace while inside on the run down the backstretch, was in a long drive on the far turn to mid stretch but was used up and faltered in the drive. NICKERS FOR CANDY raced three wide on the backstretch then made a bid and faltered in the stretch. DR. JASPER trailed throughout.
