ROSE RUN tracked the pace four wide, bid into the turn, took command mid way of the turn and remained clear under a steady drive. DEPUTY WICKETTE bumped at the start, remained well back and inside, drifted out around rivals through the stretch run to have a steady gain while no threat to the winner. UMMA UMMA stalked the pace on the rail, bid into the stretch to duel with a rival, then held the show spot safe. SPLASH OF MAGIC set the early pace off the rail, dueled with a rival through the stretch and weakened in the late stages. TAP CITY broke in at the start to bump a rival, remained well back and outside then had a mild gain in the lane. ELLSBURY tracked the pace three wide, remained with a striking position through the turn but could not sustain her bid. THATSA SOBEE mid pack and off the rail, had no rally. CIN IN CHICAGO stalked the pace between rivals, faded in the drive.
