LAWYER DAGGETT stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. POPS IS TOPS tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn, had no room and clipped heels inside the quarter pole and faded late. FERDIE'S GUY pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late. GOLD RAKER angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. STORMIN' BUFFALO was never a threat. ROYAL CROWN COSMO set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. STREAK O GREY was through after a half. MORE MONEY HONEY was done early. THE RIDER OF POPS IS TOPS CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF LAWYER DAGGETT FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE EARLY STRETCH BUT IT WAS DISALLOWED.
