HUNTINGTON'S BEST chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. SHORT SALE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then took over and led in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. BENJI BLUES tracked the pace early while wide, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. SOLO GLITTERS was bumped at the start and trailed the field early, swung widest into the lane and moved up in the stretch run. BUDFREE was bumped at the start, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. LIL CON MAN was through after a half. COMING ON broke out at the start then set the pace for a half then folded up.
