QUEEN OF CLUBS was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while four wide, was in a strong drive then drew away in the end. HALFMOON stalked the early pace from the inside, took back then rallied three wide on the turn, made a bid in mid stretch but was second best in the end. TECHNICALLEE TIME set the pace and drew off heading into the turn then weakened in mid stretch. LITTLE CORDELIA dueled for the early lead from the inside, bore out entering the turn and was taken back off heels then made a mild gain in late stretch. CREATIVE KARA chased the early pace while racing two wide then faltered. MISTY JO was unhurried early then was no menace in the stretch drive. MOONRUNNER was inside on the turn but no factor in the stretch drive. MOTION EXPRESS raced four wide on the turn and was no threat.
