Footnotes

STRAIGHT SCOOTER rated in the early going, angled out through the turn, bid four wide into the stretch, drew off the last sixteenth, lasted. LITTLEBALLOFFIRE close up and five wide, fanned to six wide to bid into the stretch, closed willingly to be second best. WEST ON WALLSTREET fractious in the gate, was sent hard to be close up and outside, bid on the three path into the stretch, drifted in and weakened in mid stretch. MOROX sent from the gate to be well placed and outside, was forced to wait for racing room in the stretch, then had a mild gain when clear. RESTORING HOPE had a rail trip and passed tiring rivals. WAKI BIRD well placed on the rail, angled out into the stretch, faded in the drive while drifting in. HOBO JO close up and four wide, fanned five wide into the stretch, then had no rally. LANA'S DREAM unsettled in the gate, set the early pace on the rail, faltered. BERNIE'S BOY vied for the lead outside, then was through after a half. SLICK TOWN MONKEY trailed the field.
