FLYING ROSSETTA set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then remained clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. SEMINOLE LADY stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch but did not have enough. BELLA BABY tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. CALI STYLE was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. CHAPOLTE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. PETTICOAT LANE angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. TUDIE POP angled off the rail into the turn and was empty in the stretch. RIVA'S DISPUTE was through after a half.
