MEMAWS BABY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared the field late. SHAKIN SUN stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. SILENCEONSUNDAY set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. PAVARAZZI was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. MORGANSMOONSHINE raced up close early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. LATER BABY broke awkwardly from the gate and was no threat. PERFECT JAB was done early. SHE HOPES TO DANCE was through after a half. I SURVIVED SARA was getting out through the turn. THAT DRESS had brief speed then folded up.
