PROFESIONAL GRADE set the pace well off the rail, turned back a challenged from CAVANAUGH into the stretch, got clear and lasted. JIMANATOR well back and outside, moved up four wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, dueled with CAVANAUGH through the lane, edged ahead of that one at the eighth pole and held the place safe. CAVANAUGH stalked the early pace outside, came three wide to bid into the stretch, dueled with a rival and weakened the final furlong. ARABIAN CHEETAH stalked the early pace from between rivals, gained a striking position through the turn, was blocked into the stretch, angled in and got through inside of rivals, then ran evenly the final furlong. LIFE'S LESSONS second flight and between rivals, gained a striking position through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and lost ground. ESPRESSO DOBLE moved up. CITIZEN stumbled at the start, tracked the early pace inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and had no rally. VERY CLEAR was never involved.
