### Footnotes

NORTHERN CANDYRIDE stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn then took over command and drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. LUCKY CHUCK was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch run. MAN FROM MARS set the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch. OLD SMOOTHIE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive. OAK RICH was done early.
