SODA JERK pressed the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then took over command and drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. HOLY BULLHIVE was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. SEA OF ENQUIRY tracked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn with no late gain in the stretch run. SHOT OF KELA was on the inside into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. SHAFTED stalked the pace early, fanned into the seven path in the turn and faded late. ONE TUFF STORM set the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. WIN TUCKER was done early.
