Footnotes

TURBO JET EXPRESS broke sharply from the gate to stalked the pace from the outside, edged to the lead at the quarter pole, dueled through the stretch with NAME THAT SONG and got up in the final stride. NAME THAT SONG never far back, pulled to contention four wide, headed the pace setter through the turn, dueled through the stretch and missed in the final stride. CLASSICAL RHYTHM well placed on the rail in the early going, angled three wide into the stretch, close well to be best of the rest. SIR WILLIAM E far back in the early going remained on the rail to save ground and gain a striking position, then could not threaten while closing willingly. PASS THE PIPE tracked the pace off the rail, lost ground through the turn, angled out into the stretch to have a mild gain. STORMY ATTITUDE mid pack and three wide, angled widest for the stretch run and flattened out. BULLFEATHERS showed little. I. C. MET close up and three wide, bid five wide into the stretch, then had no rally. HINES JR. sprinted to a clear lead, stopped. COSMIC SKY trailed the field.
