Footnotes

FOLLOW THE RULES stalked the pace inside, angled out to bid into the stretch, drove clear late under steady handling. JEFF THE CLOCKER well back and off the rail, fanned six wide to bid into the stretch, closed fast to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. LITTLE SMOOTHY set the early pace off the rail, gained a clear lead through the turn, drew off into the stretch, weakened in the late going. FLYING LOOT close up and outside, bid on the five path into the stretch, then had a mild stretch rally. SANDS RED BARON had a rail trip and showed little. KARATE KING close up and outside, angled wider to bid through the turn, faded in the stretch. CIRCUS TRICKS trailed the field.
