**Footnotes**

BROTHER JAMIE set the early pace inside, deflected a bid from WAKI PASSAGE through the turn, dueled with MR. MINK through the stretch run, prevailed. MR. MINK broke sharply from the gate to be close up and three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, dueled with the winner through the stretch run, hung. ARE N AIDE well back and inside, fanned to the four path to bid into the stretch, made a steady gain to get up for the show outside late. RARE POWER broke in to bump a rival at the start, void of speed and on the rail, closed willingly on that path to gain a share. MOONSHINE STILL passed tiring rivals. WAKI PASSAGE stalked the pace from between rivals, dueled with the winner through the turn, flattened out. SOLON EXPRESS well placed on the inside, angled out into the turn to bid, weakened in the drive. NEED MONEY DAD was no factor. BRASS BOLT was never involved.
