BULLNOSE BRICK was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. KNOB CREEK stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. COOL LION tracked the pace early from the inside, angled into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. CODE BLUE set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. PRAYER ANSWERED chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. SMOKEY AROMA was through after a half. STONE WARRIOR was done early. BRIAN'S PEAK was always outrun and was distanced.
