LIGHTNING JACK set a well rated pace, was in control then drew off in upper stretch then was much the best. TOUGH LITTLE NUT bobbled at the start then chased the pace while inside, saved ground on the far turn making a bid but was second best in the end. GROOM HIS DEVIL stalked the pace while racing four wide, into the turn, was in a long drive and was outfinished in the drive. BRENT THE BANKER was unhurried early on then made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch drive but was no threat. GOLD DIGGIN GROOM was allowed to settled then raced on the inside, saved ground on the far turn and was no menace. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKEY chased the pace while taking two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but failed to menace. GREAT SKY DANCER chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up then stopped.
